

INTRODUCTION

St. Joseph's on Capitol Hill

St. Joseph's Church on Capitol Hill is a historic Roman Catholic parish located at 313 2nd Street NE, Washington, D.C. Established in 1868, it has served the Capitol Hill community for over 150 years. The church's design was inspired by the Cologne Cathedral in Germany, and it was constructed using brownstone from Hershey, Pennsylvania. It was dedicated in January 1891 by James Cardinal Gibbons.

The church is known for its beautiful Gothic architecture and its close proximity to significant landmarks like the U.S. Capitol and the Supreme Court. Over the years, it has been a place of worship for many notable figures, including members of Congress and Supreme Court justices. St. Joseph's continues to be a vibrant community, offering various religious services and community activities.

The current St. Joseph's Campus is located at the southwestern corner of 2nd Street NE and C Street NE, occupying lots #806, #52, and #47 of square #756. The campus includes a four-story building at 333 2nd Street NE, with a public alley abutting the northern boundary and the eastern boundary shared with the public alley and the neighbor at 224 C Street NE.

Campus Description

The campus is currently composed of six structures and a surface parking lot:

- The Church structure, approximately 70 feet wide by 145 feet long, with a spire adorning the southeastern corner of the campus.
- The Rectory, a two-story building built in 1888 at the center of the campus.
- The Madonna House, an early 1900s three-story residential building at the southeastern corner.
- St. Thomas More Center, occupying a 1903 carriage house along the alley at the northeast.

- The Parish Center, a concrete masonry building situated between the Rectory and St. Thomas More Center.
- Lastly, a concrete masonry one-car garage located along the eastern edge between the Madonna House and St. Thomas More Center.

Scope

The Church is seeking to enhance its services to the community and neighborhood. To meet the growing needs of its community, St. Joseph's is pursuing a multiphase renewal of its existing campus:

- Phase I New Parish Center & Renewed St.
 Thomas More Center
- Phase II New Residential Building
- Phase III New Educational Center

The proposed design in this submission corresponds to Phase I. Phase I includes the betterment of the Parish Center and a renewed St. Thomas More Center. The design includes the following program:

- 150-person community gathering space
- Three classroom spaces
- Practice choir room
- Fully equipped kitchen
- Outdoor gathering space

Proposed Design

The design team worked closely with the Church to deliver the vision of a welcoming structure that respects the heritage of the Church and surrounding buildings. With that in mind, the team conducted site observations and a historic study of the campus and surroundings to understand the physical and usability constraints.

The proposed design is pursuing the following:


- The renewal of the carriage house to include three classroom spaces, a kitchen, and restrooms.
- A new building attached to the carriage house is proposed, replacing the existing CMU structure housing the Parish Center.
- The new addition will include a 150-person community space, a reception area, and a choir room.
- A new gated outdoor courtyard.
- Upgrading the vehicular pavement entrance, enhancing the pavements for the exterior courtyard.




FLOOR PLAN FOR PARISH CENTER - LEVEL 01








FLOOR PLAN FOR PARISH CENTER - LEVEL 02












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PARTIAL BUILDING ELEVATION - NORTH













