






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PROJECT LOCATION

The DC Streetcar Car Barn Training Center is the operational and maintenance facility for DC Streetcar and located at 2550 Benning Road NE, west of the Anacostia River and adjacent to Spingarn High School, Langston Terrace and the Langston Golf Course.



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HISTORIC DISTRICTS AND PROPERTIES

The project location is shown within two historic districts

- Kingman Park Historic District
- Young, Brown, Phelps and Spingarn Educational Campus Historic District



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FUNCTIONAL RELATIONSHIPS EXISTING

The CBTC facility has served to make DC Streetcar a local institution. *But:*

- Not enough track space for expanded fleet to allow for safe movement
- Exterior car wash not functional when weather is inclement
- Not enough storage and inventory space for an expanded fleet
- In-house maintenance not possible due to lack of space and facilities
- Not enough offices for operations personnel

FUNCTIONAL RELATIONSHIPS EXPANSION

The expansion of the facility solves these deficiencies by:

- Adding track storage capacity for safe movement with new expanded fleet.
- Providing in-house capabilities that will improve service and efficiencies
- Encloses the car wash area to make it usable in any weather
- Provides required storage for inventory
- Provides required office space for Operations Department



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PROJECT SCHEDULE

The project schedule summarizes key milestones in the planning, design and construction of the addition to the CBTC. It is critical that construction is completed by January 2026 so the site can accept the delivery of the new street cars.



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


KEYMAP FOR PHOTO LOCATIONS



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

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


SITE PLAN (AS-BUILT)






GROUND LEVEL (AS-BUILT)






LEVEL 1 (AS-BUILT)






LOW ROOF AND MEZZANINE (AS-BUILT)




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NEW FAÇADE SCHEME - CUES


- Preserve the "superstructure" motif
- Fenestration indicates a different function
- Show the inner workings of the facility
- Creating more spaces to gather
- Don't mimic, but live in same family of moves
- Next to -- but at a respectful distance


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SITE PLAN

Features:


- Dedicated Parking for DDOT Inside DDOT Property Line/ Security
- Shared Access Road w/ DDOT and Spingarn
- Spingarn Truck Loading Access
- Minimized height of retaining walls
- Mimic natural hillside slope
- Re-introduce green
- Maintains viewshed of Spingarn and Langston Terrace from Benning Rd.





SITE SCHEME

- Maintains natural sloping landscape
- Relocate existing foliage and match existing plantings
- Parking and driveway are raised to make retaining walls less high and prominent
- Maintains sidewalk connection running between school and site
- Short (3'6) Retaining wall at driveway will be obscured by streetcars









SECTION THROUGH NEW TRACK AND PARKING













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SITE MATERIALS

- Permeable pavers with grass, like existing
- Fencing to match existing
- Brick or masonry walls, color selected to harmonize both with Spingarn and CBTC
- Retaining walls tinted to emphasize earth tones









ROOF PLAN








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FIRST FLOOR PLAN
