Site Context: The historic gatehouse at 3001 R St NW is in Georgetown, an area recognized for its diverse architectural styles. Nearby residential homes on R Street date from the late 19th to early 20th century, showcasing Italianate, Federal, and Victorian styles, marked by brick facades, decorative cornices, and bay windows. Bedside's Residential dwellings, the primary surrounding public spaces in the area are Oak Hill Cemetery itself, and Montrose Park. Oak Hill Cemetery, designed by William Rufus Wilson in 1848, features notable monuments in Romanesque and Gothic Revival styles. The gatehouse was designed by architect James Renwick Jr., also known for the Smithsonian Castle, and serves as an entrance to Oak Hill Cemetery, contributing to the neighborhood's historical significance. Montrose Park, located a block away, offers landscaped gardens and walking paths.







Figure 2: Residential homes facing the property on R Street

Oak Hill Cemetery: The cemetery serves as a 22-acre fixture within the historic Georgetown neighborhood. Home to winding paths, matured plantings, and the grave sites of notable American artists, generals, and inventors, the space serves dual use as both a private memorial and public amenity.



Gate House: Residence of current Superintendent of cemetery, Paul Williams; Designed in Italianate style and built c. 1850. Entrance is found at the intersection of R and 30th Street



Existing Project

Site: Partially obscured by an existing iron fence, the site of the proposed project is composed of a small lawn space behind the gatehouse and the gatehouse garage. Small shrubs and two Holley trees line the perimeter of the outdoor space



Design Proposal: The proposed design aims to beautify the existing outdoor space, as well as provide spaces for cemetery engagement events, such as private donor events and public activities




Figure 4: Plan view of lawn space

Fireplace Veneer: Stucco

• Same stucco material as represented, will be outdoors



Fireplace Crown & Bilco Bar Gate Veneer:

• Same copper veneer to be found on both fireplace crown and both the wall veneer & gate of the bilco bar



EXISTING CONDITIONS

Existing Brick Patio The brick patio is in good condition.

Existing Brick Walk The current brick walk is in acceptable condition.

Existing Water Vault The water vault is in acceptable condition but in prime real estate.

Existing Plant Material

There are three mature American Hollies on the property that provide shade. There are a few shrubs along the outbuilding and privets along the fence. There are 3 large shrubs between two of the Hollies, along with some hostas. There are lots of perennials around the existing brick patio.

PROPOSED DEMOLITION

Existing Brick Patio The brick patio is in good condition. Some brick will be removed and reused for the patio's new footprint.


Existing Brick Walk

The current brick walk is in acceptable condition but will be removed. Bricks will be reused in patio's new footprint.

Existing Water Vault The water vault is in acceptable condition but in prime real estate. It will be rotated so as to not be in the dining terrace. It will then be hidden by plant material.

Existing Plant Material


There are three mature American Hollies on the property that provide shade that will remain. There are a few shrubs along the outbuilding and privets along the fence that will be removed. There are 3 large shrubs between two of the Hollies, along with some hostas that will remain if the design permits. There are lots of perennials around the existing brick patio. Some will remain unless they need to be removed to make way for new work.

DESIGN MATERIAL

SITE DEMOLITION

-Existing brick walkway, step into house kitchen, and some bricks in the existing patio to be removed.

LOUNGE TERRACE

Design Intent: Re-lay existing brick pavers. Provide a permanent location for the grill that is out of the lounge and dining spaces. Add a fireplace with Old Georgetown aesthetic. **Construction:** Brick paving will be dry laid on CR-6. Fireplace will have a concrete footer to frost depth; CMU foundation; stucco veneer & crown. The Bilco Bar and Prep Area will be stick built with PT lumber, with copper veneer. The Bilco Gate will match the Bilco

Bar & Prep Area. Brick Paver: Reuse existing Pattern: Running bond Fireplace Veneer: Stucco Fineplace Crown: Stucco Finish: Smooth coat Prep Area Veneer: Copper Prep Area Counters: 1.25" Limestone Bilco Bar Wall Veneer: Copper Bilco Bar Counters: 1.25" Limestone

GARDEN TERRACE

Design Intent: Provide a relaxing place to lounge and enjoy the water sounds while watching the birds. **Construction:** Paving on typical 4" setting bed. **Paving:** Resin Bound Crushed Oyster Shells

Design Intent: Architectural lighting; illuminate water feature. **Construction**: Typical low-voltage landscape lighting.



Plan View


